Sacrament of Communion

- We practice open communion, meaning that all adults and older youth who profess Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior are invited to commune.
- Gluten-free bread is served in the trays of the bread.
- Grape juice is served in the trays of the cup.
- At 8:00 worship, communicants will be invited to come forward in groups, forming a semicircle in front of the chancel steps. Communicants will first be served the bread and invited to partake, then will be served the cup and invited to partake. Once all in each group have been served, a blessing will be offered and communicants may return to their seats down the side aisles.
- At 10:30 worship, communicants will be served in the pews, partaking at one time as led by the pastors.
