LOGOS: PreK/Kind - God made my nose, 1 Corinthians 12:12, 14-27. Upon returning, we continued to talk about our five senses. Focusing on our sense of smell, we discussed how our nose helps us, from smelling to holding up our glasses. Our craft for the night was made ahead of time: Kool-Aid play dough. The children were able to smell and play with watermelon, lemonade, grape, and orange. The room smelled very fruity and fun! 3rd Grade - We studied Genesis 37-45 learning that like Joseph, God is always with us, no matter how bad it looks. 4th Grade -In our continuing study of worship, this week our focus was on what we as Christians believe - The Apostles' Creed. The class has been challenged to memorize the creed for next Wednesday!

Senior High Sunday School: Our lesson comes from Exodus 13-14, where we confirm God does indeed protect His people. We look at all the ways God delivers through water: Noah's ark, Moses' basket, the parting of the Red Sea, the crossing of the Jordan River, and Jonah's three days in the fish.
