Scripture Reading – Philippians 2:1-11

If you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any fellowship with the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, ² then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and purpose. ³ Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. ⁴ Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others. ⁵ Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: ⁶ Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, ⁷ but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. ⁸ And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death-- even death on a cross! ⁹ Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

- 1. Triumphal Entry An emotionally charged atmosphere, divisions of people
 - a. Crowd four groups
 - i. Disciples eager, yet puzzled
 - ii. Pilgrims for the Passover Feast saw Jesus as the fulfilment of OT prophecies
 - iii. Religious Leaders angrily determined to get rid of Jesus
 - iv. Residents of Jerusalem under the influence of the religious leaders
 - b. Reaction and emotions of Jesus stern, exasperated response to the Pharisees; he wept over the unbelief in the city
 - c. Remember what came next clearing of the temple, unbelief continued
- 2. Hymn "Lead On, O King Eternal"
 - a. Days of preparation
 - b. Your grace has made us strong
 - c. Holiness shall whisper the sweet amen of peace
 - d. Deeds of love and mercy the heavenly kingdom comes
- 3. Philippians 2:1-11
 - a. If you have any...encouragement, comfort, fellowship, tenderness and compassion
 - b. Then make my joy complete by being...like-minded, same love, one in spirit and purpose
 - c. Do nothing out of vain conceit...but in humility
 - d. Look to your own interests (oxygen mask) and the interests of others
 - e. Attitude...same as that of Christ Jesus
 - i. Being in very nature God...did not consider equality...something to be grasped
 - ii. Taking the very nature of a servant
 - iii. Humbled himself...became obedient to death...even on a cross
 - iv. God exalted him...highest place...above every name
 - v. At the name of Jesus...every knee should bow
 - vi. Every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord
