Pastoral Prayer – Sunday, May 10

O Lord, across the country we see unemployment soaring.

1. Some are parents who are forced home as schools are closed and they now need to educate their school-age children. And on top of the challenge of switching jobs to be full-time educators, they have the burden of providing for kids with reduced or eliminated incomes.

2. Some are patients who depended not only on their salaries, but also on their work-supplied health insurance. Now they're not sure how they'll pay their medical bills. Some might even be considering foregoing needed medicines and treatments.

3. Some have professions that disqualify them from unemployment benefits (such as small business owners, or contractors (such as some hair stylists)), and so the financial strain is multiplied without government assistance.

As money grows tight, we feel the grip of fear and worry, threatening to take hold of our minds and hearts. Grant us, O Lord, the peace that passes understanding; the peace which rests not in our savings or salaries or stimulus checks, not in our investments or insurance or unemployment benefits, but which rests completely in your sovereign care for us. Jesus invites us to consider the sparrows, who don't plant or harvest or store food in barns, yet they still have enough, because God himself provides for them. Jesus invites us to consider the wildflowers, who don't spin or sew or buy clothes, but yet are beautifully dressed, because God himself clothes them. Jesus invites us to consider how much more than sparrows and wildflowers our God loves us, and will surely provide for us what we need to eat and drink and wear. And this frees us to seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness.

O Lord, we pray: as you free us of the worry of self-provision, fill our hearts and minds with the work of the kingdom. Grant that we might be free to be generous, sharing what we have rather than hoarding. Grant that through our peace, the world might be attracted to you, and the firm foundation you provide for our lives. We trust you, and your provision, O Lord. We will wait for you. And as we wait, we will persevere in the work to which you have called us: peace, love, and generosity. In Jesus' name, amen.
