SERMON NOTES - "WALKING WITH GOD"

Question of the morning: Do you feel spiritually inferior, in light of comparing your own sense or depth of faith to others?

Know the truth of Hebrews 10:14 - "because by one sacrifice he (Jesus Christ) has made perfect forever those who are being made holy."

Spirituality is not about us, but about Christ's sacrifice. God initiated our relationship with him and walks with us.

The Lord's assurance - Leviticus 26:12 "I will **walk among you** and be your God, and you will be my people."

The Lord's call to us:

Deuteronomy 10:12-13 "And now, O Israel, what does the Lord your God ask of you but to fear the Lord your God, **to walk in all his ways**, to love him, to serve the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, ¹³ and to observe the Lord's commands and decrees that I am giving you today for your own good?"

Joshua 22:5 "But be very careful to keep the commandment and the law that Moses the servant of the Lord gave you: to love the Lord your God, **to walk in all his ways**, to obey his commands, to hold fast to him and to serve him with all your heart and all your soul."

Jeremiah 7:23 "Obey me, and I will be your God and you will be my people. **Walk in all the ways** I command you, that it may go well with you."

Micah 6:8 "He has showed you, O man, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to **walk humbly with your God**.

Paul recalls the Lord's assurance - 2 Corinthians 6:16 "As God has said: "I will live with them and **walk among them**, and I will be their God, and they will be my people.""
