SCRIPTURE READINGS

Psalm 66:16-20 ¹⁶Come and listen, all you who fear God; let me tell you what he has done for me. ¹⁷I cried out to him with my mouth; his praise was on my tongue. ¹⁸If I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened; ¹⁹but God has surely listened and heard my voice in prayer. ²⁰Praise be to God, who has not rejected my prayer or withheld his love from me!

1 Corinthians 2:1-10 When I came to you, brothers, I did not come with eloquence or superior wisdom as I proclaimed to you the testimony about God. ² For I resolved to know nothing while I was with you except Jesus Christ and him crucified. ³ I came to you in weakness and fear, and with much trembling. ⁴ My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power, ⁵ so that your faith might not rest on men's wisdom, but on God's power. ⁶ We do, however, speak a message of wisdom among the mature, but not the wisdom of this age or of the rulers of this age, who are coming to nothing. ⁷ No, we speak of God's secret wisdom, a wisdom that has been hidden and that God destined for our glory before time began. ⁸ None of the rulers of this age understood it, for if they had, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory. ⁹ However, as it is written: "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love him" -- ¹⁰but God has revealed it to us by his Spirit.

The Christian Church - some descriptive thoughts from scripture:

- Matthew 16:18 "...you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church..."
- Acts 9:31 "Then the church throughout Judea, Galilee and Samaria..."
- Acts 12:5 "Peter was kept in prison, but the church was earnestly praying to God..."
- Acts 14:23 "...appointed elders for them in each church..."
- Acts 20:28 "Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. Be shepherds of the church of God, which he bought with his own blood."
- 1 Corinthians 14:12 "...try to excel in gifts that build up the church."

Leadership Appointments:

- Mark 3:13-15 "Jesus went up on a mountainside and called to him those he wanted, and they came to him. ¹⁴ He appointed twelve -- designating them apostles -- that they might be with him and that he might send them out to preach ¹⁵ and to have authority to drive out demons."
- John 15:16 "You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit -- fruit that will last."
- Acts 13:47 "I have made you a light for the Gentiles, that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth."
- 1 Corinthians 12:28-31 "And in the church God has appointed first of all apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then workers of miracles, also those having gifts of healing, those able to help others, those with gifts of administration, and those speaking in different kinds of tongues. ²⁹ Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Do all work miracles? ³⁰ Do all have gifts of healing? Do all speak in tongues? Do all interpret? ³¹ But eagerly desire the greater gifts. And now I will show you the most excellent way."
