SERMON NOTES: "CHANGE - WE'RE FAR FROM NORMAL"

Scripture - 2 Timothy 3:10-17

On August 7th, we considered three words from the "Called to Campus" resources: "unsettled, uncertain, unknown." Called to Campus used those words to describe life on campus in light of the pandemic. As people grew weary of pandemic protocols, there was a loud cry to return to "normalcy."

"Unsettled, uncertain, unknown" – can be applied to all decades, all centuries of history – change is inevitable.

Instead of looking for or wanting normalcy, Christians are charged to live by Scripture.

2 Timothy, chapter 3, begins with a stern warning of the terrible times in the last days, of godlessness running rampant; then, beginning in verse 10, Paul charges Timothy to continue with what he has learned and become convinced of.

2 Timothy 3:15 – "...have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus."

2 Timothy 3:16 – "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness..."


