SCRIPTURE READINGS

Deuteronomy 6:4-5; Proverbs 3:3-6 - ⁴ Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. ⁵ Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. ³ Let love and faithfulness never leave you; bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart. ⁴ Then you will win favor and a good name in the sight of God and man. ⁵ Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; ⁶ in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight.

2 Timothy 3:10-17 - ¹⁰You, however, know all about my teaching, my way of life, my purpose, faith, patience, love, endurance, ¹¹persecutions, sufferings--what kinds of things happened to me in Antioch, Iconium and Lystra, the persecutions I endured. Yet the Lord rescued me from all of them. ¹²In fact, everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted, ¹³while evil men and impostors will go from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived. ¹⁴But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it, ¹⁵and how from infancy you have known the holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. ¹⁶All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, ¹⁷so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

SERMON NOTES: "CHANGE - WE'RE FAR FROM NORMAL"

Scripture - 2 Timothy 3:10-17

On August 7th, we considered three words from the "Called to Campus" resources: "unsettled, uncertain, unknown." Called to Campus used those words to describe life on campus in light of the pandemic. As people grew weary of pandemic protocols, there was a loud cry to return to "normalcy."

"Unsettled, uncertain, unknown" - can be applied to all decades, all centuries of history - change is inevitable.

Instead of looking for or wanting normalcy, Christians are charged to live by Scripture.

2 Timothy, chapter 3, begins with a stern warning of the terrible times in the last days, of godlessness running rampant; then, beginning in verse 10, Paul charges Timothy to continue with what he has learned and become convinced of.

2 Timothy 3:15 - "...have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus."

2 Timothy 3:16 - "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness..."

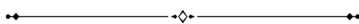

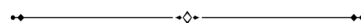

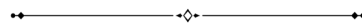
